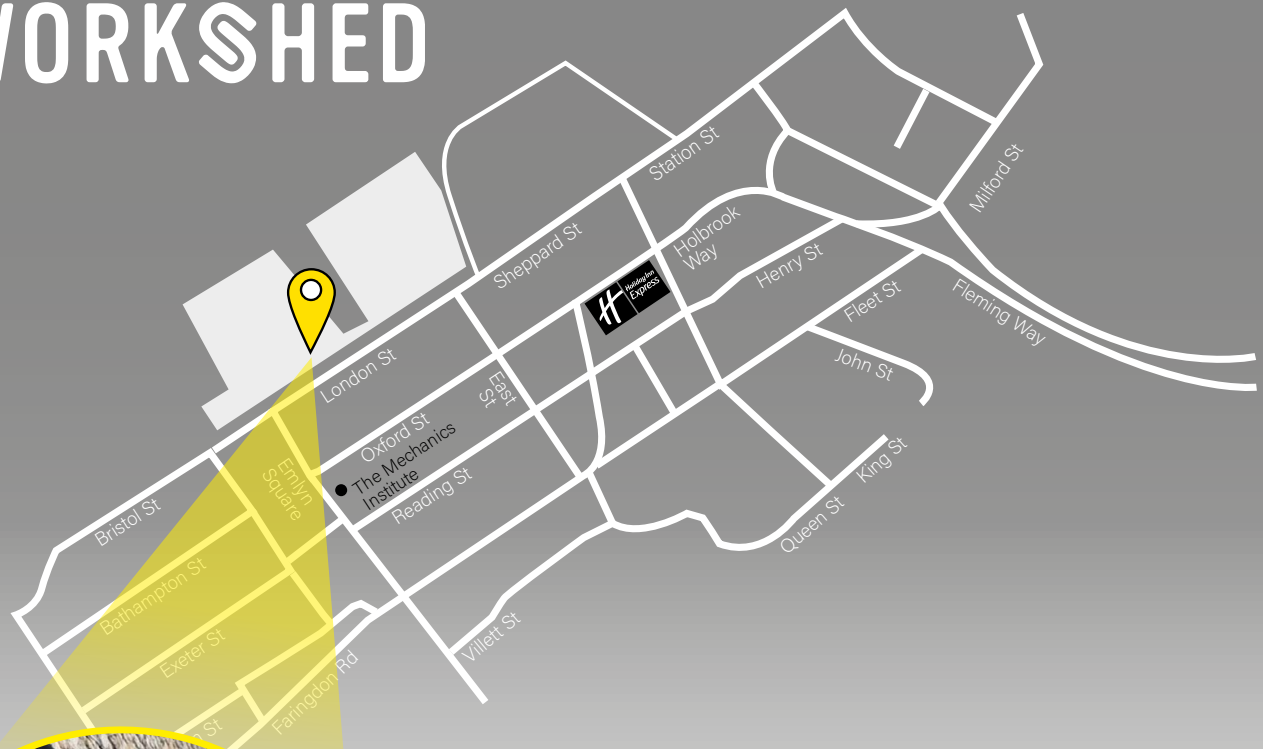


WORKSHED



Where is Workshed?

Workshed is located in the former Brunel's Railway Carriage Works in the historic Railway Village. Carriage Works residents include; [Create Studios](#), [Royal Agricultural University \(Cultural Heritage Institute\)](#), [UTC](#), [Tom Faulkner \(Modern & Contemporary Handmade Furniture\)](#) and the [Institute for Circular and Sustainable Technologies \(Innovation Centre for Applied Sustainable Technologies\)](#). We are also just on the other side of the railway line from the historic Churchward site with McArthur Glen Swindon Designer Outlet, Heelis (National Trust HQ), English Heritage, Historic England and the National Monuments and Records Centre.

Arrive by foot/train

Our main entrance is 7 Carriage Works on London Street (opposite house number 6A London Street).

Coming from the train station, turn right out of the station, passing car park entrances on your right and after approx. 300 metres, Workshed is on the right-hand side of London Street, just before you get to the disused Mechanics Institute on the left (and before the pedestrian tunnel to the McArthur Glen Swindon Designer Outlet).

Coming through the tunnel from McArthur Glen Swindon Designer Outlet/National Trust/English Heritage etc, turn left and our entrance is about 20 metres on the left (the 4th door)

Arrive by car

Pre-booked parking is available at Workshed.
Email info@theworkshed.co.uk for more information.

There are 2 main car parks near Workshed and both are pay & display.

[Bristol Street Car Park \(SN2 2GZ\)](#) closest to Workshed
From within Bristol Street Car Park, walk away from the big white cooling tower towards the covered access road and buildings including Cultural Heritage Institute (CHI). Passing the CHI on your right, go through the covered access road between industrial units and turn right when the tunnel ends. The rear entrance to Workshed is on your right.

Swindon Train Station Main Car Park (SN1 1DQ)

From Main Station Car Park, walk down the car park access ramp to Sheppard Street, turn right and walk approx. 300m along the front of the Carriage Works building. The entrance to the building is on the right hand side, with a sign above the door.

Other parking available at McArthur Glen Swindon Designer Outlet North Car Park (SN2 2NA). From there, follow pedestrian signs to town centre, go down the ramp to walk through underpass to Bristol Street, turn left and the entrance to Workshed is just 20 metres on the left the 4th door.

[Brunel North and Brunel West Car Parks \(SN1 5AH\).](#)

Cross over Faringdon Road, walk past disused Mechanics Institute. The entrance to Workshed is on the right on London Street.

Arrive by Bus

Regular bus services are provided by [Swindon Bus Company](#) and [Stagecoach West](#). Emlyn Square and London Street bus stops are a short walk to Workshed.
